SAFE CLOTHING

For safety, children should not wear the following:

- Crocs or sandals
- Short shorts
- Crop tops
- Bikinis without a T-shirt and shorts over the top

Without suitable alternatives, a child may be unable to take part in climbing, rafting or paddleboarding.

COLLECTION

COLLECT BY 17:00

- The collecting adult must bring photo ID. Staff may check it against the authorised collection list.
- If somebody different will collect, call 07596 005613 so their identity can be verified.
- If you are running late, call as soon as possible. Two staff will remain with your child until collection.

LATE COLLECTION FEE: £15 PER 15 MINUTES AFTER 17:00

THE DAY

We aim to spend at least half of each day on the water, subject to safe weather conditions. The rest of the day develops practical skills through adventurous land activities.

WATERSPORTS MAY INCLUDE

Kayaking, canoeing, paddleboarding, rafting, coracles and sailing.

LAND ACTIVITIES MAY INCLUDE

Climbing, axe throwing, archery, bushcraft, pioneering, orienteering, crafts, team building and sports.

WEATHER

Children should arrive with a warm waterproof coat, hat and gloves. We often paddle in the rain. If conditions make water sessions unsafe, the programme moves to adventurous land activities.

ON-SITE CAFE

Camp children receive discounted cafe prices. Hot chocolates and slushies are £3; soft drinks are £1.50. Water and squash are free for bottle refills.

IF THE SITE HAS TO CLOSE

We will contact the primary caregiver as soon as possible. We will provide either a refund for days missed or a credit voucher to use another time.
